



# Smokey Timbers Camp Requirements

**Updated for 2022 – Please Read Carefully**

**To make stays at Smokey Timbers more enjoyable for everyone, we have created the following requirements to help assure a quiet, clean and safe environment.**

- Quiet must be maintained between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. The operation or use of any noise-producing device which unreasonably annoys others **at any time** is prohibited. The use of properly muffled generators is permitted between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.
- Guests visiting a registered group are welcome, but must leave by 10:00 p.m.
- Campfires & cooking fires are permitted in the designated fire rings provided. The rings should not be moved. All campfires must be out by midnight and should never be left unattended. Fire permission is regulated by the Minnesota DNR according to conditions/weather.
- Domestic pets are allowed but must be leashed, kenneled or under control, **at all times**. Responsible cleanup is required.
- Guns and ammunition can be allowed with prior approval. Explosives, of any kind, including fireworks, are prohibited in the camp.
- Fishing is allowed anywhere along the camp's lakeshore property except in the swimming area when swimmers are present. Adherence to Minnesota DNR fishing regulations is required.
- Adult supervision of children anywhere on the property is required at all times. Their safety, welfare and enjoyment is extremely important to all of us! **Please make certain they stay off the Retaining Wall rocks.**
- Swimming is at the camper's own risk. **No lifeguard is provided by the camp. Diving from the dock is prohibited.**
- Entry into and exit from the facility must be through the Smokey Timbers Road gates.
- Motorized vehicles are generally restricted to the Parking Lot. Exceptions for camper units (tent and travel trailers, small motorhomes, etc.) with prior approval at the time of registration are allowed. Smokey Timbers is not liable for damage incurred by camper units. Vehicles may be unloaded/loaded in the buildings area but parking there is prohibited. Exceptions for handicapped guests are allowed with prior approval.
- Camper Units should not be parked in the vehicle parking lot.
- Trails are for hiking, bicycling, skiing or snowshoeing only. Powered equipment is not allowed except for handicapped individuals, maintenance, supervision or safety activities as necessary.
- Campers must not venture onto neighboring private property. Please respect the Camp's neighbors.
- The possession and consumption of alcohol or use of tobacco products when youth groups are present is prohibited. Permitted use must leave no trace. The use or possession of any illegal substance will not be tolerated.
- Individuals who are under the influence of any substance and/or are boisterous, rowdy, disorderly, or otherwise disturb the peace at any time will be required to leave the Camp.
- Food supplies and garbage need to be animal-proofed. Garbage must be put in plastic bags and properly disposed of. Garbage should never be placed in campfires. Garbage and Recycling containers are located near the Kitchen building. Responsible recycling is practiced here. Deep burial of fish entrails in remote areas of the Camp is allowed.
- Camp sites and common areas must be maintained and left neat and clean. Good camper etiquette assumes that responsible guests will leave the environment and all facilities in as good or better condition than when they arrived.

**I have read and agree to comply with the requirements of Smokey Timbers Camp. I fully understand that if our group does not comply with these requirements, we will be asked to leave, will forfeit our deposit and fees and will not be allowed to return. We will accept full reasonable financial responsibility for damages caused by our campers, participants and visitors. We are committed to doing our best to assure the future of Smokey Timbers.**
